SUMMER SCHOOL

Farmersville High School will be conducting summer school classes beginning June 9th and concluding July 7th. Classes will be held Monday thru Friday with the exception of Friday, July 2. The hours of class each day are from 8 – 10:10 and 10:20 – 12:30 p.m. Students may take two classes per day at a cost of \$50 per class. Classes for credit recovery will be available in math, science, English, and history. Students will be able to regain one semester credit in each class period if they satisfactorily meet the requirements of the course. Students must not miss more than two days of classes and must achieve a grade of 70 or higher to receive any credits. Summer school remediation classes for juniors who fail the exit level TAKS will also be offered.

TAKS TESTS

Farmersville High School will be conducting the state-mandated TAKS tests during the week of April 27 – 30. Please encourage your students to get plenty of rest the night before and do their best. These tests are used to determine student progress and the effectiveness of the school academic program. Students who fail the tests will be required to attend remediation classes for the next school year. Students who pass all of their tests and do not exceed nine absences for the semester will be granted exemptions for spring semester exams in the TAKS-tested subjects. Juniors must pass all exit level TAKS before they can graduate from high school.
